Grant of Options

Magnum Mining and Exploration Limited ("the Company") is pleased to advise that it has today granted 2 million unlisted options, exercisable at \$0.075 per share on or before 31 December 2019, to the Company's Senior Geological Consultant, Mr Stephen Konecny.
